Women's EffectivenessMain Text: Acts 28:16-31; 1 Corinthians 9:16-27

Key Terms:

Witness - one who bears an account by his/her own 5 senses and knows; those who lives testifies to the worth and effect of faith received. (1Pet.5:1) A declaration of facts (Acts 4:33)

Confident – assurance (Eph.3:12) boldness (Acts 28:31) to be of good courage (2 Cor. 5:6; 7:16)

Reference Religions of the World

Ramakrishna – "Many faiths are but different paths leading to one reality, God."

<u>Hindus</u> – submits to karma as through a series of reincarnations to live ethically and submerge self in the divine.

<u>Buddhists</u> – seek to extinguish desire and achieve the nothingness of Nirvana as the end of countless reincarnated lives.

<u>Muslims</u> – performs the duties of the Five Pillars of Islam: pray 5xper/day, fast, give alms, and go to Mecca.

<u>Judaism</u> – observe the Law of Moses and pursue an ethical life.

Note: Four great world religions are alike in that they point out spiritual paths along which men and women try to reach God by earning His acceptance.

Questions: Do you know your religion? Which Christian Denomination doesn't adhere?

<u>Christianity</u> – is distinct. It teaches that people cannot reach God by their efforts. Instead, God entered human history through Jesus Christ and provided the sacrifice that makes salvation available as a non-strings-attached gift. (Eph. 2:8-9)

Proverbs 21 King James Version (KJV)

21 ²Every way of a man is right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts.

³To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.

⁴An high look, and a proud heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin.

Discussion:

Main Texts Acts 28:16-31; 1 Corinthians 9:16-27

- 1 Corinthians 9 King James Version (KJV)
- **9** ¹⁶ For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!
- ¹⁷For if I do this thing willingly, I have a reward: but if against my will, a dispensation of the gospel is committed unto me.
- ¹⁸ What is my reward then? Verily that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my power in the gospel.
- ¹⁹ For though I be free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more.
- ²⁰ And unto the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might gain the Jews; to them that are under the law, as under the law, that I might gain them that are under the law;
- ²¹To them that are without law, as without law, (being not without law to God, but under the law to Christ,) that I might gain them that are without law.
- ²²To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some.
- ²³ And this I do for the gospel's sake, that I might be partaker thereof with you.
- ²⁴Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.

- ²⁵ And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.
- ²⁶I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air:
- ²⁷But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

Application:

Ephesians 3 King James Version (KJV)

- **3**⁶ That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:
- ⁹And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
- ¹⁰To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,
- ¹¹According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:
- ¹²In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.
